STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relative to the Salary of the Judge and the Recorder and Clerk Hire of the Brunswick Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1903, c. 277, § 11, amended. Section 11 of chapter 277 of the private and special laws of 1903, as last amended by chapter 48 of the private and special laws of 1953, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 11. Salary of Judge. The judge of said court shall receive an annual salary of \$3,000 \$4,000 in full for all services, payable quarterly on the last days of March, June, September and December from the treasury of Cumberland county.'
- Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1903, c. 277, § 8, amended. The 4th sentence of section 8 of chapter 277 of the private and special laws of 1903, as last amended by chapter 49 of the private and special laws of 1953, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'For all services performed the said recorder shall receive from the county of Cumberland an annual salary of \$7,800 \$2,000 and \$600 \$750 annually additional for clerk hire, to be paid to him in quarterly payments.'
