SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1207, L. D. 1476, Bill, "An Act
Relating to School Age in Public Schools."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of that part designated
"Sec. 44" of section 1 thereof the following underlined sentences:
'Residence as used in this section shall mean the city or town
where the father maintains a home for his family. If the parents
of the child are separated, residency shall be considered to be
the town where the person having custody of the child maintains
his or her home.'
