SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1213, L.D. 1484, Resolve Providing
for Survey to Re-route the Maine Central Railroad
in City of Portland.

Amend said Resolve by striking out every thing after the
Title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Survey to re-route the Maine Central Railroad.

Resolved: That upon application of the municipal officers
of the City of Portland the State Highway Commission is authorized
to make a preliminary survey to determine the desirability and
feasibility, including a preliminary estimate of the cost and
traffic impact, of re-routing Maine Central Railroad tracks
and right of way, from its present location from the point where
it leaves the Union Station in Portland to the area of the point
where the same crosses the Grand Trunk Railroad lines. The cost
for such preliminary survey shall be as determined by the State
Highway Commission, and shall, if the survey be undertaken, be
apportioned equally between the city of Portland and the State High-
way Commission.'
