COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 543, L.D. 1485, Bill, "An Act to Appropriate Monies for the Purchase of Salk Vaccine."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'<u>Purchase of Salk Vaccine</u>; appropriation for. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare out of the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the State for the purchase of Salk Vaccine the following sums:

1955-56	<u> 1956-57</u>
\$60,000	\$15,000

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.'
