SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 546, L.D. 1487, Bill, "An Act Relating to License Plates for Motor Vehicle Owners

Who Operate Amateur Radio Stations."

Amend said Bill in the 7th line of that part designated "Sec. 47-A" by striking out the underlined figure "\$1" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$3'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the last 4 lines of that part designated "Sec. 47-A" and inserting in place thereof the following underlined words and punctuation:

'shall be issued passenger plates. The Secretary of State, with the approval of the Governor and Council, is authorized and directed to issue such plates of a color different from the regular issue and of a number and letter designation of such a type as to indicate the operator who owns an unrevoked and unexpired official amateur radio license, to transmit radio signals from portable or mobile units, issued by the Federal Communications Commission.
