STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Providing for a Fish Screen at the Outlet of China Lake, in the Towns of China and Vassalboro, in the County of Kennebec.

Outlet of China Lake; screening of. Resolved: That the sum of \$490 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game, for installing a fish screen at the outlet of China Lake in the towns of China and Vassalboro, Kennebec county; provided, however, that China Lake Fish and Game Association shall assume all liability for maintaining said screen and keeping said screen free from all sticks, leaves and debris so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same; and provided further, that the State shall be liable for only $\frac{1}{2}$ the cost of said screen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

China Lake has been, and is being, heavily stocked with salmon, and this screen is considered to be necessary to prevent heavy losses from fish going downstream.
