**AN ACT Relating to Compensation of Boards of Registration in Cities of 50,000
Inhabitants or More.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 3, § 13, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 13 of chapter 3 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

'In cities of 39,000 inhabitants ~~or more~~ and less than 50,000 inhabitants, the chairman of the board shall receive \$2,850 per year and the other 2 members of the board shall receive \$2,500 per year and such additional amounts as may be authorized by the municipal officers or Board of Finance.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 3, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 3 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows :

'In cities of 50,000 inhabitants or more, the chairman of the board shall receive \$3,150 per year and the other 2 members of the board shall receive \$2,800 per year and such additional amounts as may be authorized by the municipal officers.'
