John J. McDonough; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$264.61 to be paid to John J. McDonough of Westbrook, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State, for damage done to his 1948 4-door Chevrolet Sedan, by 2 State School Boys while they were on escape.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. John J. McDonough's 1948 4-door Chevrolet Sedan, license No. 71-248, was taken by 2 boys from the State School on June 10, 1953. The front end was wrecked and repairs amounted to \$264.61.
