HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to S. P. 564, L. D. 1521, Bill, "An Act  
Repealing Obsolete Highway Laws and Clarify-  
ing Project Completion Dates."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof a new section  
to read as follows:

"Sec. 7. R.S., c. 23, Sec. 15, amended. Section 15 of Chap-  
ter 23 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the  
end thereof a new sentence to read as follows:

'The State Highway Commission is further authorized and empowered  
to limit the weights and dimensions of vehicles which may lawfully  
use any one or more of the highways of the State, below the limits  
permitted by the provisions of chapter 22, to the extent necessary  
to secure to the State any Federal funds apportioned to the State  
under the provisions of said Federal Aid Road Act, as amended and  
supplemented, or under the provisions of any other Federal Act  
relating to highways.'"
