## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 97th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1235, L.D. 1525, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Boilers and Unfired Steam Pressure
Vessels."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following sections:

"Sec. 3. R. S., c. 30, Sec. 67, amended. The 1st sentence of section 67 of chapter 30 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The Board shall formulate rules for the safe and proper construction, installation, repair, use and operation of steam boilers in this state.'

Sec. 4. R. S., c. 30, Sec. 83, amended. The 1st sentence of section 83 of chapter 30 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No steam boiler or unfired steam pressure vessel that has been condemned for further use in this or any other state by an authorized boiler inspector employed by an insurance company or by an inspector authorized to inspect boilers by a state or the Federal Government shall be operated in this State at-a-guage pressure-ef-ever-15-peunds.'"
