RESOLVE, Providing for Splashboard on Waterville-Winslow Bridge.

Splashboard for sidewalk on Waterville-Winslow Bridge; appropriation.—Resolved: That the State Highway Commission be and hereby is authorized and directed to construct a permanent splashboard for the sidewalk on the Waterville-Winslow Bridge, so-called; and be it further

Resolved: That funds for such splashboard shall be appropriated from the general highway fund and shall not exceed \$1,500, of which such sum the city of Waterville is directed to pay the sum of \$500 to the Treasurer of State to be credited to the general highway fund, and the town of Winslow is directed to pay the sum of \$500 to the Treasurer of State to be credited to the general highway fund; and be it further

Resolved: That the construction of such splashboard shall not be commenced until payments from the city of Waterville and the town of Winslow have been made as above provided.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Pedestrians who walk on the sidewalk of the Waterville-Winslow bridge are continually being splashed by motor vehicle travel. The purpose of this resolve is to correct this condition.
