AN ACT Providing for a Deputy Commissioner of Institutional Service.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 27, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph, 2 new paragraphs, to read as follows:

'The Commissioner (of Institutional Service) shall appoint a Deputy Commissioner, subject to the provisions of the Personnel Law. He shall perform such duties as the Commissioner may require of him.

In the event of a vacancy in the office of Commissioner of Institutional Service or during the absence or disability of that officer, the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council, may appoint the Deputy Commissioner to serve at the pleasure of the Governor and Council as Acting Commissioner and to perform all the duties of the Commissioner during such vacancy, absence or disability.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Institutional Service the sum of \$7,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956 and \$7,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1957.
