IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Limestone for Aid Extended to Frederick Bell.

Town of Limestone; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$5,982.40 to be paid to the town of Limestone to reimburse said town for aid given to Frederick Bell of Limestone.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On September 11, 1954, Frederick Bell was injured because a bridge on Route 165 was washed out by a hurricane. He and his family for medical care and support have been aided by the town of Limestone in the amount of \$5,982.40. Although the case has settlement in Limestone, the town should be aided because of the unusual circumstances.
