COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 23, L. D. 14, Bill, "An Act Directing
Review of Election Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the word "assistance" in the
10th line, the words 'and hold such public hearings'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of "Sec. 2" and
"Sec. 3" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the
unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the State the sum of
\$7,500 to carry out the purposes of this Act. Said sum shall not
lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30,
1959.'
