STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Saul Jandreau of St. Francis Plantation for Beaver Damage.

Saul Jandreau; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$400 to be paid to Saul Jandreau of St. Francis Plantation as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage done to his land by beaver.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Jandreau's land, because of flooding by beaver dams and because of the beaver themselves, has been harmed by the destruction of timber, pulpwood and hard wood.
