STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse St. Francis Plantation for Certain Pauper Supplies.

St. Francis Plantation; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$2,100 to be paid to St. Francis plantation to reimburse said plantation for aid given to Mrs. Elmer Wright and family, now of Millinocket.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The amount of \$2,100 was paid by St. Francis plantation to Millinocket for aid to Mrs. Elmer Wright and family for pauper supplies. Reimbursement from the State would be of great financial assistance to St. Francis.
