COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 23, L.D. 28, Bill, "An Act to Amend
the Charter of the Town of Mount Desert to Give the
Selectmen Authority to Make Ordinances."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of "Sec. 5-A" and inserting
in place thereof the following underlined section:

'Sec. 5-A. Traffic by-laws or ordinances. The selectmen of the
town of Mount Desert may adopt by-laws or ordinances, for the control
of traffic, not inconsistant with law, and may enforce them with
suitable penalties for the purposes and with the limitations as
specified under the provisions of sections 86 and 87 of Chapter 91
of the Revised Statutes of 1954.'
