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**AN ACT Relating to State Owned Cars for Supervising State Fire Inspectors.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 16, § 30, amended.** The 1st paragraph of section 30 of chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The State shall provide no automobiles for travel of employees; ~~provided, however, that this~~ **This** shall not apply to the Governor, the State Police, Department of Inland Fisheries and Game, Department of Sea and Shore Fisheries, **supervising state fire inspectors**, inspectors in the Motor Vehicle Division of the Secretary of State, supervisors in the Maine Forestry District, Highway Department nor to such heads of departments or members of commissions as the Governor and Council may from time to time designate. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to preclude the maintenance of a reasonable and proper number of state owned cars to be operated from the departmental garage, for occasional or emergency use, upon application to and approval by the State Purchasing Agent.'
