# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Cremation of Old State Bonds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 18, § 28, amended. Section 28 of chapter 18 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- **'Sec. 28. Cremation of old bonds.** The Treasurer of State, in the presence of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration and the State Auditor, is authorized and empowered to cremate any state bonds and coupons which have matured and been paid, and have been held by the Treasurer for a period of at least 5 years after such payment the date of maturity. A cremation certificate, signed under oath by the above-named state officers identifying the bonds destroyed, shall be filed in the office of the Treasurer of State.'
