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**AN ACT Relating to Fees to be Paid to Insurance Commissioner for Division of  
Fire Prevention.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 60, § 314, amended.** The 4th paragraph from the end of section 314 of chapter 60 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘For each license issued to a manufacturer of lightning rods, ~~\$20~~ \$50; for each license issued to an agent of such manufacturer, ~~\$2~~ \$10; and such fees shall be credited to the Division of Fire Prevention to defray the expenses of the Division. Any balance of said fees shall not lapse but shall be carried forward as a continuing account to be expended for the same purposes in the following fiscal years ;’

**Sec. 2. R. S., c. 97, § 45-A, additional.** Chapter 97 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 45-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 45-A. Permits for storage and transportation of explosives. The fee for a permit for the storage of and transportation of each truck of more than 200 pounds of explosives shall be \$25. Such fee shall be credited to the Division of Fire Prevention to defray the expenses of the Division. Any balance of said fees shall not lapse but shall be carried forward as a continuing account to be expended for the same purposes in the following fiscal years.’

**Sec. 3. R. S., c. 97, § 48-C, additional.** Chapter 97 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 48-C, to read as follows:

**'Sec. 48-C. Examinations by Division of Fire Prevention.** The fee for examination by the Insurance Commissioner through the Division of Fire Prevention of each set of plans for construction, reconstruction or repairs of public buildings, schoolhouses, hospitals, convalescent homes, nursing homes, theaters or other place of public assembly shall be \$25. Such fee shall be credited to the vision of Fire Prevention to defray the expenses of the Division. Any balance of said fees shall not lapse but shall be carried forward as a continuing account to be expended for the same purposes in the following fiscal years.'

**Sec. 4. R. S., c. 100, § 57, amended.** The 3rd sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 57 of chapter 100 of the Revised Statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**'The fee for such license shall be \$10 and such fee shall be credited to the Division of Fire Prevention to defray the expenses of the Division. Any balance of said fees shall not lapse but shall be carried forward as a continuing account to be expended for the same purposes in the following fiscal years.'**

**Sec. 5. R. S., c. 100, § 60, amended.** Section 60 of chapter 100 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting before the last paragraph thereof, a new paragraph, as follows:

**'The fee for a license to operate any type of motor vehicle racing shall be \$25. Such fee shall be credited to the Division of Fire Prevention to defray the expenses of the Division. Any balance of said fees shall not lapse but shall be carried forward as a continuing account to be expended for the same purposes in the following fiscal years.'**

**Sec. 6. R. S., c. 100, § 73, amended.** The 3rd and 4th sentences of section 73 of chapter 100 of the Revised Statutes are hereby repealed and the following sentences enacted in place thereof:

**'The fee for such inspection shall be \$25 and the fee for such license shall be \$25. Such fees shall be credited to the Division of Fire Prevention to defray the expenses of the Division. Any balance of said fees shall not lapse but shall be carried forward as a continuing account to be expended for the same purposes in the following fiscal years.'**

**Sec. 7. R. S., c. 100, § 74, amended.** The 2nd sentence of section 74 of chapter 100 of the Revised Statutes is hereby repealed and the following sentences enacted in place thereof:

**'The fee for such examination shall be \$10 and a fee for such license shall be \$10. Such fees shall be credited to the Division of Fire Prevention to defray the expenses of the Division. Any balance of said fees shall not lapse but shall be carried forward as a continuing account to be expended for the same purposes in the following fiscal years.'**
