STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Burning of Motor Vehicles, Airplanes and Boats.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 131, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 131 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Burning of other buildings, vessels, bridges, etc. Whoever willfully and maliciously burns any building of his wife or of another not mentioned in the preceding section 2, or any motor vehicle, airplane, boat, vessel, bridge, lock, dam or flume of his wife or of another, shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one year nor more than 10 years.'
