IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

An ACT Relating to Splash Guards for Motor Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 141-A, amended. Section 141-A of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 339 of the public laws of 1955 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 141-A. Splash guards. Every motor truck and motor truck trailer operated in or upon any way shall be equipped with suitable guards which will effectively reduce the spray or splash to the rear of mud, water or slush caused by the rear wheels thereof.'
