SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" relating to a bill  
entitled, "An Act Revising Law Relating to Dealer and  
Transit Motor Vehicle Registration." (H.P. 41, L.D. 54)

Amend said Amendment by striking out everything in the first  
paragraph of Sec. 26-C after the underlined word "of" in the 14th  
line of Sec. 26-C and inserting in place thereof the following  
underlined words, "at least \$10,000 on account of injury to or  
death of any one person, and subject to such limits as respects  
injury to or death of one person, of at least \$20,000 on account  
of any one accident resulting in injury to or death of more than  
one person, and of at least \$5,000 for damage to property of others."
