AN ACT Relating to Definition of Beaver Dams.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 119, amended. The last sentence of the last paragraph of section 119 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'A beaver dam is defined as a dam that actually maintains water for a live colony of beaver.'
