AN ACT Relating to the Appointment of Dedimus Justices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 11, § 7, amended. Section 7 of chapter 11 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding after the 1st sentence thereof, a new sentence, as follows:

'Dedimus justices shall hold office for 4 years and no longer, unless reappointed.'

Sec. 2. Application. Dedimus justices in office on the effective date of this act shall continue in office for 4 years after the effective date of this act.
