SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 60,
L. D. 64, Bill, "An Act to Incorporate the Town of
Jackman."

Amend said Amendment by striking out in the 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th and 15th lines in "Sec. 3" the words and punctuation "the 3 secular days next preceding such special meeting, the 1st and 2nd days thereof to be devoted to the registration of voters and the 3rd day to enable the board to verify the corrections of said list and to complete and close up their records of said sessions" and inserting in place thereof the words 'on the day of election and on such additional days thereto as they may determine'
