**RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension
for Marion Hilton of St. Albans.**

Marion Hilton; state pension increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Marion Hilton of St. Albans, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

That part of Chapter 194 of the resolves of 1949 which provided for a state pension for Marion Hilton of St. Albans, is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Miss Hilton is 54 years of age and is unable to work out. One leg is 4 inches shorter than other leg, needs special shoe. She has epilepsy, needs money for hearing aid and glasses expenses.
