RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Beverly Ann Archer of Rumford.

Beverly Ann Archer; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Beverly Ann Archer, of Rumford, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Beverly Ann Archer is 8 years of age and has cerebral palsy. She is one of 4 children and has a twin who is almost deaf. Beverly has to be taken to Waterville to clinics. The father is a common laborer.
