COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 54, L.D. 70, Bill, "An Act to Create the Bangor Water District.

Amend Section 1 of said Bill by striking out the first sentence of the 3rd paragraph of section 1, and inserting in place thereof the following:

'For all purposes of the act the aforesaid water system and appurtenances thereto shall include, without being limited to, the pumping facilities, filter plant and standpipes used in the operation of the existing water system of said city of Bangor; such of said city's land and buildings as at the effective date of this act are used in connection with its said water system and not primarily used for other purposes, together with said city's water mains, water pipes and conduits, flowage rights and flowage easements used or useful in the conduct of its existing water system.'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out the words "Mountainy Pond" in the 4th line thereof.
