RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Magalloway River and its Tributaries, Oxford County.

Magalloway River and Tributaries; regulating fishing. Resolved: The Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Magalloway river, from the New Hampshire line to its junction with the Second East Branch and the Third East Branch, Oxford County, from September 1st to September 30th, inclusive, annually to all fishing except fly fishing and establishing a daily limit of one fish; and be it further

Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing the rest of Magalloway river and its tributaries, Oxford County, to all fishing except fly fishing and establishing a daily limit of 5 fish.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The law as it is at present on the river presents an enforcement problem, due to the fact that there is a five fish limit on the river proper, and a fifteen limit on the tributaries. Also, the present law is not recorded with the Clerk of Courts of Oxford County.
