STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Appointment of Deputy Treasurer, Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 129-A, additional. Chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 129-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 129-A. Deputy treasurer of Kennebec county; appointment; bond. The treasurer of Kennebec county may appoint a deputy treasurer who shall assist the treasurer in performing the duties of his office. Such deputy treasurer shall give bond to the county for the faithful discharge of his duties in such sum as the county commissioners order and with such sureties as they approve in writing thereon, the premium of such bond to be met by the county.'
