STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Minimum Speed of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 112, repealed and replaced. Section 112 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 112. Minimum speed regulation. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at such a slow speed as to impede the normal and reasonable movement of traffic except when reduced speed is necessary for safe operation or in compliance with law.

Whenever the State Highway Commission or municipal officers in their respective jurisdictions determine on the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that slow speeds on any part of a highway consistently impede the normal and reasonable movement of traffic, the Commission or such municipal officers may determine and declare a minimum speed limit below which no person shall drive a vehicle except when necessary for safe operation or in compliance with law.'
