STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of St. Francis Plantation.

St. Francis plantation; appropriation. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$1,000 to aid in constructing about 500 feet of road on Route 161 beginning about 3 miles southwest of St. Francis plantation and in tarring about 1½ miles on said road.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This road is in bad condition. There is considerable traffic on it, including trucks hauling pulpwood, and school buses.
