STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Clean Salmon Spawn Beds at Square Lake Thoroughfare.

Salmon spawn beds; cleaned. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to clean the salmon spawn beds at the Square Lake Thoroughfare, Aroostook county, of all sticks, logs and debris.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Such cleaning will help to create a better atmosphere for the spawning salmon; enlarge the potential spawning grounds; resulting in a smaller mortality in young fish and finally in an increase in fish in that chain of lakes.
