AN ACT Creating Deputy Municipal Tax Collectors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 91, §§ 31-32, amended. Sections 31 and 32 of chapter 91 of the Revised Statutes are hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 31. Deputy treasurers and collectors. The treasurer and the collector of any town or plantation may appoint a citizen thereof as his deputy during his temporary absence or other temporary disability. The appointment shall be in writing and be recorded. It may be in the form following:

"I,, hereby appoint
to perform the duties of town treasurer (**collector**) of the town of,
during the treasurer's (**collector's**) temporary absence from his office.
..... Treasurer (**Collector**)."

Sec. 32. Treasurer and collector responsible. The treasurer and the collector of any town and the sureties upon his official bond are responsible for all acts and omissions of his deputy in such office.'
