**AN ACT Relating to Power of Municipalities in Collection of Personal
Property Taxes.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 91-A, § 47, amended. Section 47 of chapter 91-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section one of chapter 399 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended, by adding a new subsection, at the end thereof, to be numbered VI, to read as follows:

'VI. That the payment of personal property taxes of the preceding years shall be a condition precedent to the issuance of all municipal licenses and permits.'
