STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Providing for Group Life Insurance for Certain Members of the State Police.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 63-A, § 24, sub-§ I, amended. The 1st sentence of subsection I of section 24 of chapter 63-A, as enacted by chapter 451 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Except as provided herein, each appointive officer or employee of the State of Maine, or teacher, who is eligible for membership in the Maine State Retirement System, or each member of the State Police who is a member of the State Police Retirement System, shall at such time and under the conditions of eligibility as the Board of Trustees may by regulation prescribe, come within the purview of this section.'
