HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 83, L. D. 109, Bill, "An Act Relating
to Requisites for Old Age Assistance."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting
clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., c. 25, §283, sub-§VI, amended. Subsection VI of
section 283 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended
to read as follows:

'VI. Has no child or children residing in this State and able
to support him. It is the intent of the Legislature that a
child of the applicant shall not be considered able to support
him if said child has 5 or more children.'"
