### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT to Reimburse Certain Municipalities for General Pauper Relief.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 94, § 11-A, additional. Chapter 94 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered section 11-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. II-A. Reimbursement by State. Any municipality, expending more than 5% of the total local tax levy on general pauper relief under the provisions of this chapter, shall have a valid claim against the State to recover 80% of the sums paid out by reason of such general pauper relief as exceeds 5% of the total tax levy, upon proof of the facts in form satisfactory to the Commissioner of Health and Welfare; and such claims shall be presented to the Legislature next convening.'
