STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Age of Applicants to Pownal State School.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 143, amended. Section 143 of chapter 27 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 143. Management; ages of inmates. The Pownal State School, heretofore established at Pownal in the county of Cumberland, shall be maintained for the care and education of idiotic and feeble-minded males and females under the age of 5 years at the discretion of medical evaluation and between the ages of 5 years and 55 years, except that idiotic and feeble-minded state paupers or patients transferred from either State Hospital for the insane under the provisions of this chapter may be admitted after the above stated age.'
