## RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Barbara Anne Parlin of Norway.

Barbara Anne Parlin; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$25 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Barbara Anne Parlin, of Norway, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Miss Parlin is nearly 33 years of age. Because of ill health, she is still unable to earn her own living. Having always been cared for by her mother who is now 62 and not well herself, she needs assistance. Without her mother she would have no income whatever and become a town charge.
