RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Silver Lake, Kennebec County.

Silver lake; regulating fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of 5 fish and prohibiting the use or possession of live fish as bait on Silver lake (Figure Eight Pond) in Manchester and Sidney, county of Kennebec.
