RESOLVE, Opening Moose Pond, Cumberland and Oxford Counties, to Ice Fishing.

Moose pond; open to ice fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Moose pond in Bridgton and Denmark, counties of Cumberland and Oxford, to ice fishing under the general laws from ice in until March 31, except that part of the pond from route 302 south to Walkers Bridge which shall be open to fishing under the general laws from February 1st to March 31st.
