STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Services of State Police on Maine Turnpike.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1941, c. 69, § 11, sub-§ (a), amended. Subsection (a) of section 11 of chapter 69 of the private and special laws of 1941 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

'The costs for such use of the services of the State Police shall be paid by the Authority quarterly to the Treasurer of State and credited to the general highway fund.'
