IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing the Bounty on Bobcat.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 121, amended. The 1st sentence of section 121 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows: 'There shall be a bounty of \$15 **\$25** for every bobcat, loupcervier and Canada lynx which is killed within the State, to be paid by the Treasurer of State to the person killing the same upon compliance with the following conditions.'
