RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Haley Pond, Franklin County.

Haley pond; regulating fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Haley pond, located in the towns of Rangeley and Dallas, Franklin county to ice fishing for all fish except bass during February and March.
