RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Bell Pond, Piscataquis County.

Bell pond; regulating fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Bell pond, town of Monson, Piscataquis county, to all fishing except fly fishing and trolling artificial flies and establishing a day limit of 3 fish.
