STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Delivery of Absent Voting and Physical Incapacity Voting Ballots.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
