STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Military Leave Credits under State Personnel Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 63, § 28, amended. Section 28 of chapter 63 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof, a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'No credits toward retirement under the State Retirement System, nor vacation or sick leave accumulation shall be allowed beyond the period of first enlistment or induction in said armed forces of the United States unless the individual involved is required to remain in or return to military service beyond the first period of service under some mandatory provision of the Selective Service Act.'
