RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for George McCray, Presque Isle.

George McCray; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to George McCray, of Presque Isle, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. McCray was born in Fredericton, N. B. He entered the U. S. in 1888, His father was a Civil War veteran. Welfare has been refused Mr. McCray because they claim he is not a citizen. Until recently, Mr. McCray has always had money enough to take care of himself.
